- 3 Whereas, this world is rapidly becoming a more dangerous place, and
- 4 Whereas, peace is possible through strength, not weakness, and
- 5 Whereas, our electric grid is at serious risk from EMP attack, sabotage, cyberattack, and natural disasters, and
- 6 Whereas, the humiliating Afghanistan debacle has created the belief that the U.S. military, once seen as the guardian of
- 7 the free world, has become just another impotent bureaucracy at its highest levels, and
- 8 Whereas, our bloated military high command with its woke politically correct policies and politically motivated
- 9 vaccination mandates signals weakness while it threatens our military preparedness and the morale and recruitment of
- 10 young patriotic Americans, and
- 11 Whereas, Russia's invasion of the Ukraine, China's threat to Taiwan, and the nuclear ambitions of Iran call for a stronger,

WHEREAS, the City of Madison, Wisconsin has recently accepted an additional \$1.5 million dollars in private funding to administer elections and the City of Milwaukee⁴, other Wisconsin cities and the Wisconsin University System have accepted or are currently considering approval of similar donations; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of Wisconsin has refused to sign legislation banning the use of private funds in the administration of Wisconsin's elections⁵; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Constitution can be amended without the Governor's signature by both the Assembly and Senate passing a resolution in two consecutive sessions and then putting the resolution on the ballot for the citizens of Wisconsin to approve; and

WHEREAS, in the last legislative session, the Wisconsin Assembly and Senate passed such a resolution to amend the Wisconsin Constitution to ban the use of private funds in Wisconsin's elections; and

WHEREAS, Speaker Robin Vos and Senate Majority Leader Devin LeMahieu led the people of Wisconsin to believe the resolution would be passed a second time in January 2023 and put on the ballot in April so the voters can decide the issue; and

WHEREAS, Speaker Vos NOW has decided to NOT bring this resolution to the floor for a second vote in the Assembly and the Senate has not brought the resolution to the floor based on the dubious theory that the resolution would bring out Democrat voters and impact the Supreme Court race; and
